Has trouble explaining self orally	Often gets off-task
Appears perfectionistic	Has trouble completing work
Needs excessive reassurance	Resistant to suggestions
Has trouble expressing self in writing	Performs poorly on tests
Oral reading is choppy and hesitant	Often appears fatigued/low energy
Even when seated, some part of the body is moving	Has trouble generating ideas
Appears overly focused on details	Seems confused by the oral language of others
Reads slowly	Frequently absent or late to school
Has trouble recalling previously learned facts	Gives up easily
Appears disorganized	Makes unusual vocal noises
Works slowly	Talks too much
Has trouble with sound-blending	"Fiddles" with nearby objects
Erases or corrects work needlessly	Rushes to finish work
Shows letter or number reversals in written work	Seems overwhelmed by long-term/large projects
Interrupts verbally	Loses temper quickly
Has word-finding problems	Easily frustrated
